The 2024 Holiday season was off to a bustling start with our annual Christmas Market taking place for the first time-ever, on the entire main floor of our Fieldhouse. More than 140 vendors participated with thousands of people from our community and beyond attending this impressive annual special event during the first weekend in November. Plans are already underway for next year's even bigger Christmas Market!

Skate with Santa was back again with more than 500 participants enjoying a fun filled day on the ice with Santa and his friends. Our sincere thanks to our many sponsors who helped make this free community event possible. We've also welcomed several new sponsors

As our new Director of Hockey & Ice Programs, Tyler Riel has been instrumental in seeing some exciting new youth programs come to Dakota's ice under the Lazers Hockey Club banner, including a very popular 'Learn to Play' program for U7's. Lazers Hockey Club will continue offering learn to play, skill development, 4 x 4 youth league and hockey camps this coming spring and summer - check our website for registration details. Our Lazers Hockey Club also hosted the first ever Christmas Classic tournament where teams of U9's and U11's enjoyed two days of fun over the holiday season, with plans already underway for next

Dakota's Centre Court Cafe continues to flourish and is quickly becoming a wellknown 'Winnipeg Food Destination', with Mashyn Family Foods operating year-round and now serving up their Ukrainian speciality items through SkipTheDishes. The Mashyn Family and Dakota were also proudly featured at a recent Winnipeg Jets 'Ukrainian Heritage game night' with a special video feature on the game's Jumbotron, as well as supplying much of the Ukrainian food sold at the game that night. After more than \$4 million in infrastructure investments and improvements in 2024, we continue to enhance our facilities for the benefit of the community. This year, we've

been successful in securing a City of Winnipeg Renovation Grant (\$100k) to support the installation of accessible seating/viewing platforms for both the north and south rinks. This important investment will continue to ensure that Dakota's facilities are fully accessible to all of spectators in our rinks each year.

This Spring/Summer season will see some new offerings added to our ever popular events and programs, like our Spring Smash Pickleball tournament (which will have a new social night), our Spring Adult Hockey League, 4 x 4 Youth Hockey League, and Kids Summer Camps. Registration for these activities fills up quickly so please go to our website and sign up now to avoid disappointment.

Exciting plans for future development/ expansion at Dakota are coming together as we continue to work hard for our community and our beloved community centre. Stay tuned as we expect to have more to share with you in the coming months.
